It's a very exciting time here for all female hockey players as we welcome them to the Bauer Selects Family. For the past nine years the **Bauer Selects** has succeeded at being *the* elite training program for advanced male hockey players looking to be pushed in a very professional training environment. Now the Girls can enter our program at a young age and develop with new challenges and demands with our training and curriculum. For the first time ever we will be introducing Spring & Summer Training Weekends for elite female hockey players. Last year, the Bauer Selects Boy's program touched 1100+ players with their College Training weekends and Residential Camps. "Actions speak volumes" and it's clear by the amount of participation on the Boy's side that the Bauer Selects program that we are the top choice for elite hockey athletes looking to improve their games.

Despite our outstanding turnout for the Boy's, we as a hockey family are always looking to improve and take our game to another level. Beginning this spring, our program will offer Girls the same philosophical approach to how we develop and prepare our players. It's nonsensical to think we can develop highly skilled players when, from the time they are 7-8 years old, they play in 6-8 spring/summer tournaments but only practice a few times. The goal of the Bauer Selects is to offer elite players the opportunity to come together from different teams and supplement this with a better training-to-game ratio and more demanding and consistent competition at all our events. The forthcoming outline will emphasize training, testing and competition and make this a true priority over 6-8 spring tournaments, more games, and more spending. It would be the understatement of understatement, to say that the program we offer is long overdue, and we are thrilled that we have the opportunity to see a female spring/summer program instituted in the US that actually mandates development as it's lynchpin.

Our program is designed to compliment your AA/AAA team and not work in opposition with them. The **Bauer Selects** Program allows us the opportunity to evaluate players within these existing clubs and then, extract and expose them to a high level of coaching, training and competition. These girls are then given the opportunity to compete/develop to their fullest potential by displaying their talents with "like" players. Because we only come together 2-3 times, it is very important that these players continue to work with their in-season teams in the spring/summer months.

The **Bauer Selects** program fosters the best developmental environment possible for elite players, giving them exposure to high-caliber coaching and training methods and preparing them for College hockey.

Since its inception in 2005, the **Bauer Selects™** program has had unparalleled success in achieving its mission to advance its players to the highest levels of hockey in the US and Canada. Witness that more than seventy (70) **Bauer Selects** players have received NCAA hockey scholarships. More than twenty five (25) **Bauer Selects™** players have been selected to **USA Hockey's NTDP** in Ann Arbor. And out of only four birth years of **Bauer Selects™** players eligible for the **NHL Player Drafts** (91s, 92s, 93s and 94s), a

total of twenty four (24) have been NHL-drafted, including six (6) First-Rounders and five (5) Second-Rounders.

These numbers are remarkable by any measure. They are a testament to the quality of the **Bauer Selects™** program, and of course to our players and to the outstanding coaches who contribute their expertise and experience.

Only 34 players will be given the opportunity to train, compete and practice with some of the best players from around North America. At the training weekend, players will receive professional training that encompasses all aspects of their full development as athletes and hockey players. In addition to six plus hours of on-ice training, they will experience the full gamut of the highest-level training, including Sport Testing, off-ice sessions, nutrition seminars, as well as learning basic psychology of sports and competition.

All of the ***Bauer Selects*** teams are by design intended to be selective (no tryouts). And although every single player being contacted is an outstanding player, not everyone on our list may ultimately be invited to participate in our training weekends. To the highest degree possible, we will require that the players chosen take part in **all** of our events. Our hope of course is to gain a measure of stability with the various players and testing protocol.

What we are asking you to do now, therefore, is to inform us of your player's availability to take part in the listed events above. Getting our list of "which players can commit to the entire event program" will be our starting point, after which we will sit down and rank the players, an evaluation process that involves all of our Bauer Select staff.
